We carry the varieties of Calamagrostis including ' <b>Overdam</b> ' and 6' tall Perennial Plant of the Year for 2001 ' <b>Karl Foerster</b> '.
Grass-Carex		<b>Sedge</b> - Carex does well in competition with tree roots and will tolerate a limited amount of foot traffic. It is a very low maintenance plant that will stand drought for short periods of time. They are also more inclined to do well in a part-shade environment.

Grass-Chasmanthium latifolium		<b>Northern Sea Oats.</b> Well known for it's wonderful seed heads that are great for drying. Northern Sea Oats will grow to 3' and has brown flowers in the early summer starting in May.

They are great for use in rock gardens and in containers. What an accent they provide with their blue foliage. Our three varieties grow to 8-10" and require sun and good drainage. The color is very rich in the fall and makes a nice ground

Grass-Imperata cylindrica 'Red Baron'		<b>'Red Baron' . Japanese Blood Grass</b> - An unusual rich red foliage graces this plant. They must have winter mulch and lots of moisture. Japanese Blood grass makes an excellent accent and is 18" in height. Can be a spreader in warmer climates.

Grass-Miscanthus		<b>Maiden Grass</b> - One of the most popular grass genus', Miscanthus is considered the royalty of the grasses. Graceful arching foliage changes color with the seasons. Its showy plumes are excellent for dried flower arrangements in the fall and winter. They are great accents in the water garden as well. Miscanthus range in height from 4-7' and do best in sunny conditions.

They are unbeatable in form and are also well used in flower arranging. They prefer a full sun location where they mainly stay shorter in the 12"-36" height range.
